
We are pleased to inform you that according to the restriction of Hazardous Substances on Electrical and Electronic Equipment regulated by the Directive 2011/65/UE from European Parliament from 8th of June of 2011 and the COMMISSION DELEGATED DIRECTIVE (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of restricted substances:

- 1- SIDNEOR does not add to its products any of the restricted substances referred in the annex II:

Pb (0,1 %) Hg (0,1 %) Cadmium (0,01 %) Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %) Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %) Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %) Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0,1 %) Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0,1 %) Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0,1 %) Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0,1 %)

2 –Sidenor only use Pb as alloy element in steels to improve machinability and in galvanized steels and always in a content below 0,35% in Weight, as it is permitted in the Anex III of the Directive 2011/65/UE in whose article 4 and paragraph 1 these exemptions are detailed
